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#### **INSTALLATION PROCEDURE**

**NOTE:** Use the General Equipment: Interior Trim Remover.

1. Install the air damper into the Rigid light bar. See Figure 1.

- 2. Position aside the left hand (LH) side A-pillar trim panel. See Figure 2.
  - 1. Release the clips.
  - 2. Lifting upward and backward on the A-pillar trim panel, release the lower tabs from the instrument panel.



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- 3. Remove the LH A-pillar trim panel. See Figure 3.
  - 1. Remove the A-pillar trim panel tether cord hold down nut.
    - *Torque:* 55 lb.in (6.2 Nm)
  - 2. Remove the A-pillar trim panel tether cord from the post.
  - 3. Remove the A-pillar trim panel.



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4. Position the front LH seat in the full forward position. See Figure 4.

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**NOTE:** Be sure not to over articulate the lower B-pillar which may cause stress marks, creases, and or damage.

NOTE: Driver seat and seatbelt removed for clarity.

5. Position aside the top portion of the LH lower B-pillar aside. See Figure 5.

- 6. Remove the upper LH B-pillar trim panel bolt. See Figure 6.
  - *Torque:* 80 lb.in (9 Nm)



7. Release the upper B-pillar trim panel lower clip. See Figure 7.



8. Slide the upper B-pillar trim panel down, aligning the clips to the slots in the sheet metal. See Figure 8.



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9. Position the upper B-pillar down the seatbelt and out of the way. See Figure 9.



10. Remove the LH rear scuff plate trim panel. See Figure 10.



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11. Position the LH potion of the liftgate weatherstrip aside. See Figure 11.



12. Release the LH D-pillar trim panel lower clips. See Figure 12.



13. Slide the LH D-pillar trim panel up, aligning the clips to the slots in the sheet metal. See Figure 13.



  - Replace the two upper retention clips.



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15. If equipped, remove the luggage compartment package cover. See Figure 15.



  - Torque: 80 lb.in (9 Nm)



18. Position the liftgate weatherstrip aside. See Figure 18.



19. Release the clips and remove the loadspace scuff plate trim panel. See Figure 19.



20. Position the LH liftgate weatherstrip aside. See Figure 20.



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21. Remove the LH floor storage bin. See Figure 21.



  - 3. Disconnect the power outlet electrical connector.



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24. Position the rear seat backrest upward. See Figure 24.



  - Torque: 80 lb.in (9 Nm)



26. Release the LH C-pillar trim panel lower clips. See Figure 26.



27. Slide the LH C-pillar trim panel up, aligning the clips to the slots in the sheet metal. See Figure 27.



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- 28. Position aside the LH C-pillar trim panel. See Figure 28.
  - 1. Pull outward on the C-pillar trim panel.
  - 2. Slide the C-pillar down the seat belt and out of the way.
  - 3. Replace the two upper retention clips.



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- 29. Remove the LH sun visor. See Figure 29.
  - 1. Position the sun visor screw cover aside.
  - 2. Remove the sun visor screw.
  - 3. Rotate the sun visor downward.
  - 4. If equipped, disconnect the sun visor electrical connector.



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30. Remove the screw and the sun visor clip. See Figure 30.



- 31. Remove the LH rear assist handle. See Figure 31.
  - 1. Position the rear assist handle down.
  - 2. Remove the rear assist handle retainers.



32. Release the clips and magnets, then lower the LH side of the headliner. See Figure 32.



33. Remove the LH side rail nuts from inside the vehicle. See Figure 33.



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NOTICE: Use care not to break the tabs of the side rail.

- 34. Position upward the front portion of the LH side rail. See Figure 34.
  - 1. Free the side rail from underneath the windshield.

NOTE: Polyurethane from the windshield might make removal difficult at first.

- 2. Partially remove side rail.
- 3. Snap the side rail out of the bracket.



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35. Drill Hole on side wall of the LH side rail using a 3/8 in (9.5mm) drill bit. See Figure 35.

36. Remove locating clip and enlarge hole using a 3/8 in (9.5 mm) drill bit. See Figure 36.



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37. Use existing locater pin hole to route the wiring from the roof to the vehicle interior. Add silicone around hole to prevent water leaks into the vehicle. See Figure 37.

NOTE: Make sure that the wire length is long enough to secure the LED bar in place before fixing the side rail.

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- 39. Detach the clips and Remove the LH side of the steering column cover. See Figure 39.
  - 1. Detach the clips.
  - 2. Disconnect the electrical connector.
  - 3. Remove the LH side steering column cover.



- 40. Install the lightbar switch. See Figure 40.
  - 1. Drill a hole into the LH steering column cover using a 3/4 in (19 mm) drill bit.
  - 2. Insert the switch into the new hole until a you hear a click.



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- 41. Route the wiring from the light bar downwards along the LH A-pillar. See Figure 41.
  - 1. Secure to the existing harness using tie straps.



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- 42. Connect the light bar to the A-pillar wiring. See Figure 42.
  - 1. Remove the heat shrink on the A-pillar wiring. Use the provided splice kit WT-56815 for splicing.
  - 2. Apply heat shrink tubing.
  - 3. Crimp the wires to the matching color.
  - 4. Position heat shrink tube over the crimp and heat.

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- 43. Position back the LH Side rail. See Figure 43.
  - 1. Position back the LH side rail tab under the windshield.
  - 2. Position back the LH side rail and align the lightbar wiring to the slot in the side rail.
  - 3. Add silicone around hole and lightbar wire to prevent water leaks into the vehicle.

**NOTE:** Do not attach or secure the wiring bundle to the side curtain airbag or wiring.

44. Secure the wiring bundle away from the side curtain airbag. See Figure 44.

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- 45. Install the LH side rail nuts from inside the vehicle. See Figure 45.
  - Torque: 97 lb. in (11 Nm)



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- 46. Attach the light bar mounting bracket. See Figure 46.
  - 1. Insert the bolt head into the light bar.
  - 2. Install the bolt cover.
  - 3. Install the mounting bracket.
  - 4. Install the washer.
  - 5. Install the nut.
    - Torque: ?? ft. lb (?? Nm)

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- 47. Position the light bar onto the side rails and mark the holes for drilling. See Figure 47.
  - 1. Hold the light bar in position on the side rails.
  - 2. Measure 2 in (50 mm) from the base of the side rail to the bottom of the light bar mounting bracket.
  - 3. Mark the center of the light bar mounting bracket holes using a paint stick or center punch.
  - 4. Remove the light bar from the side rails.
  - 5. Using a 23/64 in (9 mm) drill bit, drill through the marks made on the top of the side rails.



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- 51. Connect the light bar switch to the instrument panel wiring. See Figure 51.
  - 1. Remove the heat shrink on the instrument panel wiring.
  - 2. Apply heat shrink tubing.
  - 3. Crimp the White wire on the instrument panel harness to the Blue wire on the switch wiring.
  - 4. Crimp the Yellow-Green wire on the instrument panel harness to the Red wire on the switch wiring.
  - 5. Position heat shrink tube over the crimp and heat.



  - 2. Install the LH steering column trim panel by attaching the clips.


