The use of a floor hoist is recommended for this installation. If you do not have access to one, use a hydraulic floor jack and jack stands to raise the vehicle.





#### Ford Performance Bronco 2.3L Chrome Tips (M-5230-BR3SC)




Ford Performance Bronco 2.3L Black Tips (M-5230-BR3SB)






### Ford Performance Bronco 2.7L Chrome Tips (M-5230-BR7SC)



Ford Performance Bronco 2.7L Black Tips (M-5230-BR7SB)






# **REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

- **STEP 1:** Position vehicle on hoist, put in park.
- STEP 2: Loosen the clamp. Torque is 35 lb.ft (48 Nm)



STEP 3: Lubricate all hangers shown below, pull off factory muffler hangers.



**STEP 4:** Remove factory system from vehicle.

## **INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:**

STEP 1: Lubricate all isolators. Then insert the new system into the expanded factory pipe, make sure the clamp is still on the exhaust pipe. Do not tighten the clamp. Note: expanded inlet may be tight and need slight adjusting at the notches.



STEP 2: Place hangers into the isolators.

STEP 3: Check your exhaust system for proper clearance under the vehicle and also for tip alignment, tighten the clamp to 32-35 ft. lbs.

STEP 4: Start vehicle and check for any leaks. If any leaks are found, determine cause (such as loose or incorrectly positioned clamp) and repair as necessary.



Note: When you first start your vehicle after the installation of your new Ford Performance Parts Exhaust System, there may be some smoke and fumes coming from the system. This is a protective water-based coating used in the manufacturing of mandrel bent performance exhaust tubing. This is not a problem and will disappear within a very short period of time after the exhaust has reached operating temperatures.
